For every two (2) stickers earned you can choose a prize from our prize cart.

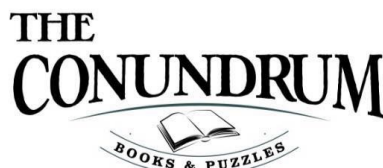
