From Seed to Swap: Growing and Sharing Plants with the LSUAgCenter

Date: Friday, March 28, 2025 | **Time:** 6:00 PM

This hands-on event will focus on the fundamentals of seed starting and transplanting, giving attendees the knowledge and confidence to grow strong, healthy plants from seed.



Leading the program is Jessie Hoover, an Extension Agent specializing in Agriculture and Natural Resources (ANR) with the LSU AgCenter, serving the Felicianas by providing guidance and research-backed knowledge to help the community grow healthier plants.

Attendees will learn:

- Best practices for starting seeds indoors and outdoors
- Tips for soil preparation, watering, and transplanting seedlings

The event will conclude with time for a plant swap, where participants can exchange seeds, rooted cuttings, bulbs, books, divided plants, gardening tools, and ideas with fellow enthusiasts. Gardening books and other resources will be available for checkout, helping attendees continue their learning beyond the event.
